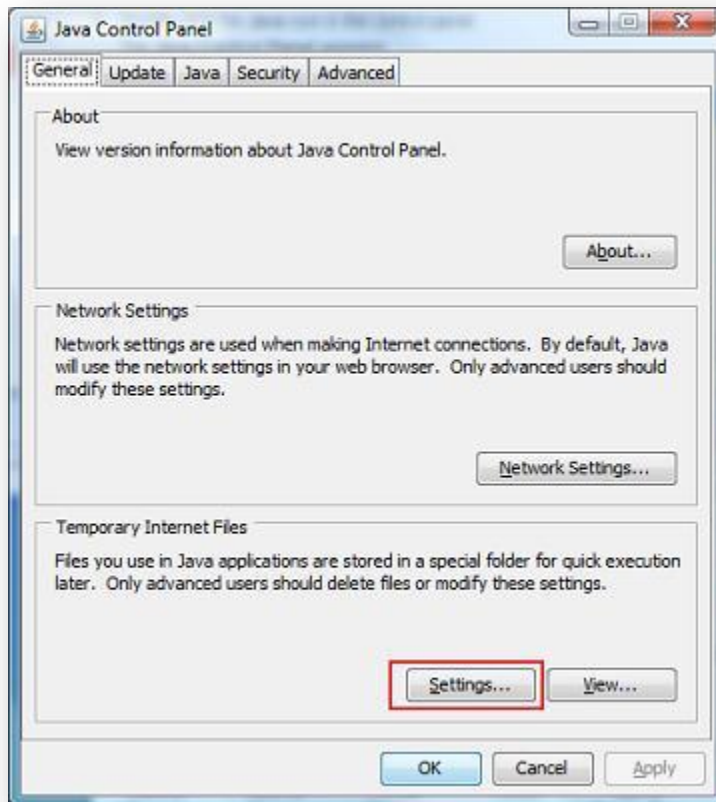

How to clear the Java Cache on Windows

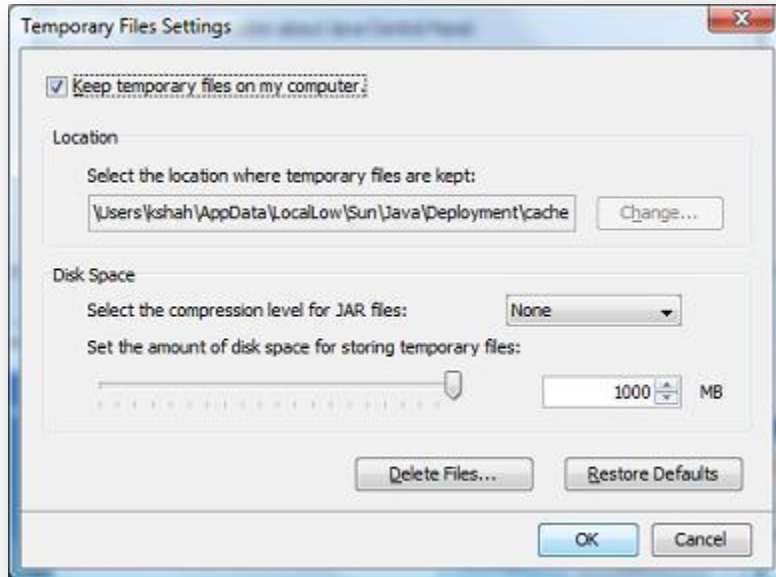
Java is a browser plug-in that allows you to do many things online. Your browser needs Java in order for you to use certain parts of webpages and applications. Clearing the Java Plug-in cache forces the browser to load the latest versions of web pages and programs and can solve many issues when trying to view or use content online.

To clear the Java Plug-in cache:

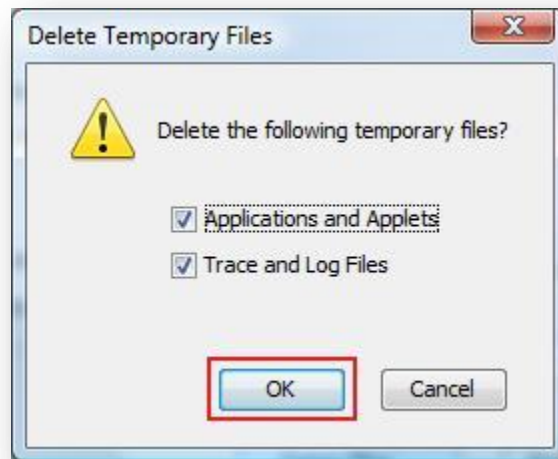
1. Click **Start > Control Panel**.
2. Double-click the **Java** icon in the control panel. The **Java Control Panel** will appear.



3. Click **Settings** under Temporary Internet Files.
The **Temporary Files Settings** dialog box appears.



4. Click **Delete Files**.
The **Delete Temporary Files** dialog box appears.

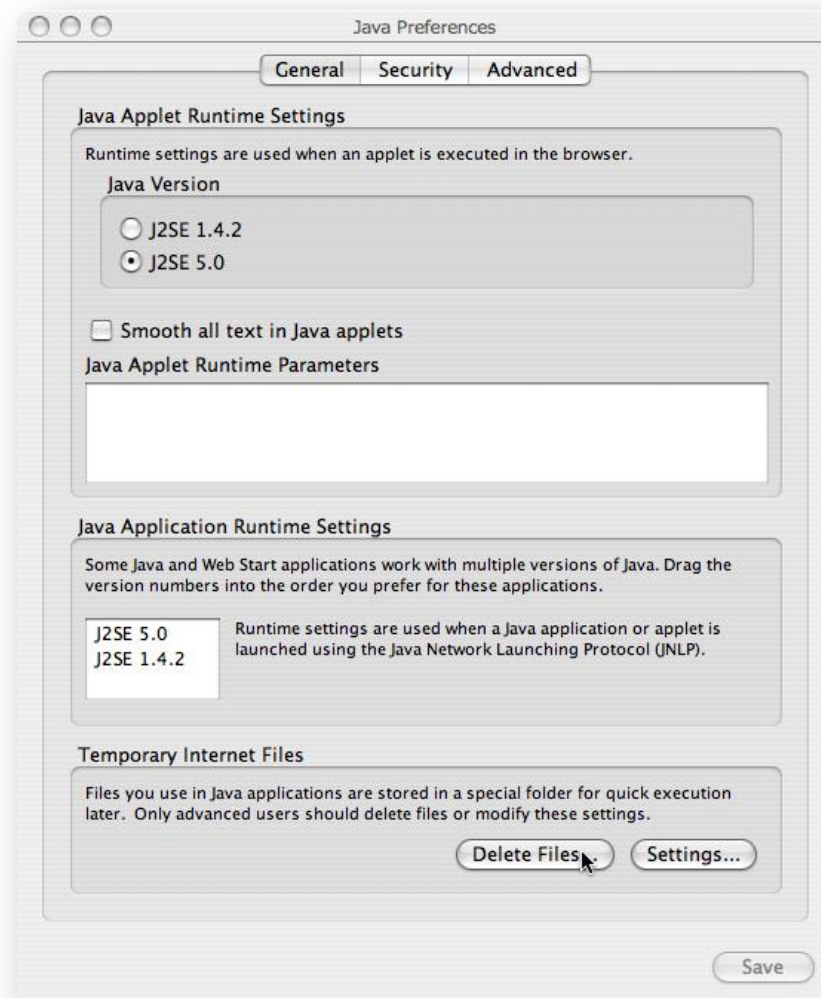


5. Click **OK** on **Delete Temporary Files** window.
6. Your Java Cache is now clear.

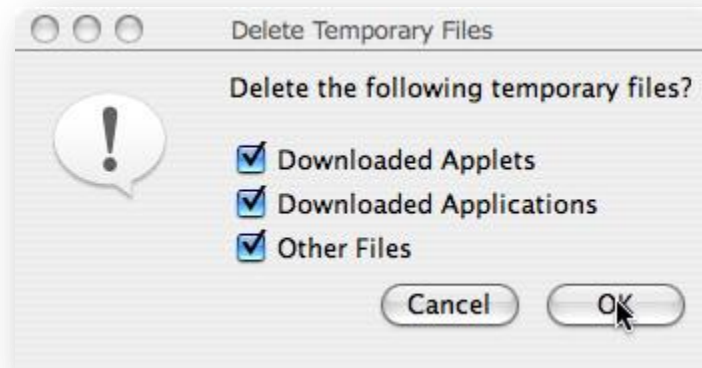
How to clear the Java Cache on Mac

Java is a browser plug-in that allows you to do many things online. Your browser needs Java in order for you to use certain parts of webpages and applications. Clearing the Java Plug-in cache forces the browser to load the latest versions of web pages and programs and can solve many issues when trying to view or use content online. To empty the cache:

1. Open **Finder**.
2. Go to **Applications**.
3. Find the **Utilities folder**.
4. Find the **Java Preferences folder**. Open this file.
5. The Java Preferences window will open. Select the **General tab**, and then click on **Delete Files**.



- Next, the Delete Temporary Files window will open, as shown below. Make sure all boxes are checked. Then, select **OK**.



- The Java cache has now been cleared.
