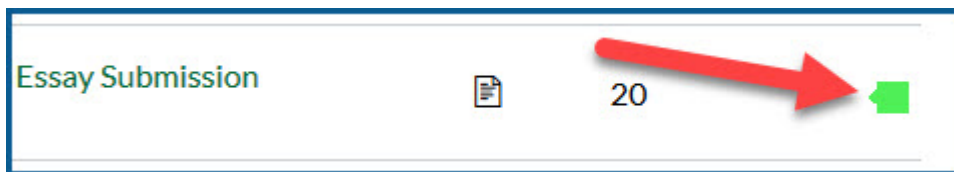


Accessing Turnitin Similarity Reports

After you submit your assignment that uses the plagiarism review tool Turnitin, you will be able to view your similarity report. [Similarity Reports](#) provide a summary of matching or highly similar text found in a submitted paper.

1. To access your similarity report, navigate to your **Grades** page from the main course menu.
2. Find the assignment for which you would like to see the similarity report. If you submitted the assignment, it automatically was submitted through Turnitin. There will be a colored icon at the end of the row for this assignment.



3. The above example has a green-colored icon, however, the colors change depending on how much similarity was contained in the submission. The possible similarity ranges are:
 - o **Blue:** No matching text
 - o **Green:** One word to 24% matching text
 - o **Yellow:** 25-49% matching text
 - o **Orange:** 50-74% matching text
 - o **Red:** 75-100% matching text
4. To view the similarities within your submission, click on that colored icon.
5. You'll be taken to the external Turnitin site where you can see the actual similarity report.
6. Click on the Match Overview icon (where the arrow is pointing) to see the breakdown of similarities highlighted in your submission as compared to other databases. This similarity report can be view by your instructor as well.
